Project Description and Estimate: The Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments (CATG) is requesting \$115,000 to complete design and preconstruction planning activities for health care provider housing in Fort Yukon. CATG will utilize the CIP funding to leverage construction funding in the form of loans through AHFC or grant funding from various other sources. It is estimated that the total construction costs for the quad-plex provider housing will be approximately \$850,000 (based on quad-plex currently being constructed in Fort Yukon for the School District).

RESOLUTION 2013-04

TITLE: FY 2014 Teacher, Health Professional, and Public Safety Housing

- WHEREAS:** The Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments (CATG) is a Tribal consortium authorized by the Athabascan tribes of the Yukon Flats; and,
- WHEREAS:** The purpose of the Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments is to conserve and protect tribal land and other resources; to encourage and support the exercise of tribal powers of self-governance; to aid and support economic development; to promote the general welfare of each member tribe and its respective individual members; and to preserve the Tribe and its Tribal members; and,
- WHEREAS:** There is no designated health professional housing in Fort Yukon or the surrounding villages; and,
- WHEREAS:** CATG has plans to construct new provider housing in Fort Yukon and surrounding villages; and,
- WHEREAS:** Attracting and maintaining a pool of qualified health professionals and public safety officials in rural Alaska is a goal of the State of Alaska and CATG; and,
- WHEREAS:** Under the Teacher, Health Professional and Public Safety Rental Development Program (THHP), competitive funding is available for new construction, rehabilitation, or acquisition of rental housing; and

Now Therefore Be It Resolved That: Ben Stevens, Executive Director of the Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments is hereby authorized to negotiate, execute and administer any and all documents and contracts required for granting funds to the Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments (CATG) and manage funds on behalf of this entity, and,

Further Be It Resolved That: Ben Stevens, on behalf of the Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments is authorized to submit an application to the Alaska Legislature Capital Improvement Program for \$115,000 in matching funds to support the construction of new provider housing in Fort Yukon.
