The federal Clean Water Capitalization Grant requires states to issue subsidies (a loan forgiveness process). The subsidy amount required was identified under the grant terms the Environmental Protection Agency has identified for Alaska. This program functioned strictly as a loan program until FY2011 when this provision was added to the federal budget. In order to implement this provision, an appropriation is necessary to properly record the loan forgiveness payment as an expense in the Alaska Clean Water Fund.
