Project Description/Justification:

The parking lot at Camp Denali Headquarters on Joint Base Richardson Elmendorf (JBER) will be replaced, reconfigured and safety upgrades installed. This is a joint federal and state funded project. The parking lot was constructed in 1991 and has exceeded its 15 year maximum life expectancy. The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) has provided proper maintenance to extend the life of the parking lot, including crack and top seal applications. These recurring repairs are becoming increasingly expensive and in some areas, larger cracks and holes have developed allowing water to seep into the substrate, where it freezes, expands, and contracts causing further damage.

The Camp Denali parking lot will continue to meet the current occupancy load requirement of the DMVA facility, providing for over 660 vehicles. Camp Denali serves as the headquarters for the Alaska Army National Guard, Alaska Air National Guard, Homeland Security and Emergency Management, Office of the Commissioner, and United States Property and Fiscal Office. Camp Denali also supports National Guard family programs and events that are held at the Armory drill hall.

This project provides for parking needs and fulfills requirements for Anti-Terrorism and pedestrian safety.
