## **Major Component Accomplishments in 2012**

Continue to provide evidence-based programming in the areas of education, vocation, substance abuse treatment, reentry, parenting and criminal thinking.

A total of 28,717 lbs of Pt. MacKenzie Work Farm produce was processed for inmate consumption.

Completed the following offender reviews:

- 7 inmates had Levels of Service Inventory-Revised risk assessments completed.
- 1 inmate had Offender Management Plans completed.
- 1 inmate had Individual Reentry Plans completed.

Provided in-house training to staff in the areas of fire, life and safety and institutional protocols. Each staff member completed approximately 37.8 hours of training.

Maintenance projects include:

- Security Fence Upgrade.
- Fence Construction.
- Lighting Upgrade.
- Kitchen Hood Extinguisher Replacement.

## **Key Component Challenges**

Recruit, hire and retain a workforce of well-trained officers to meet the challenge of facility standards and public protection.

Reduce the ongoing deterioration of the facility and backlog.

Assure that current department standards for security, safety and current correctional practices are adhered to.

Meet operational expectations while striving to remain within the fiscal parameters.

Participate in review, design, planning and coordination of facility expansion projects with department management.

Provide for timely and efficient screening and assessment of all inmates to allow appropriate placement, programming and transition to community supervision.

Inmate population continues to drive exceptional transportation and medical costs in an attempt to assure appropriate prisoner care and institutional safety. The increases to inmate populations continue to create numerous logistical and financial challenges.
