**Project Description/Justification:**

The Department of Fish and Game (Department) has numerous remote bunkhouses, cabins, support structures and other small camp type units in various locations across the state. Many of these sites are very old and substandard, and have had little or no maintenance or upgrades in several years. Many of these units are also quite remote with limited access. This project will provide funding to repair, upgrade and retrofit several remote site cabins and support structure facilities, and remote field housing units across the state. Initially the Department will focus on repairs and upgrades to a variety of small remote cabins and support structures, then follow with repairs and upgrades to a substandard and old combination cookhouse/sleeping facility at the Wood River research site outside of Dillingham.

A representative listing of sites with known needed repairs include: Alagnak cabin, Egegig tower camp, Eshamy River camp, Coghill River camp, Lowrie Island camp, Lewis River Slough camp, Haines/Chilkoot river camp, Barrow Umiat cabin site, Salmon Bay floating wannigan/camp, and Happy Valley Haul Road cabin.

Other projects may be added or substituted as needs require.
