Project Description/Justification:

The Department of Fish and Game (Department) has a variety of existing facilities across the state that are utilized on a daily basis as enclosed secure storage (heated/cold) and other similar facilities that serve as workshops/equipment garages in support of field operations. Secure and safe storage of equipment and supplies, as well as safe indoor workshops/sealing facilities has become problematic in many of the remote locations that the Department maintains. Additionally, pilferage and theft is ever increasing as well as costs to maintain old and outdated facilities. Due to the age and condition of many of these facilities the Department has begun a systematic project to assess, upgrade, and/or replace many of these facilities. Current known locations with immediate needs for these types of facilities to be upgraded are: King Salmon, Dillingham, Haines, Kodiak, Tok, Yakutat, Unalakleet and McGrath.
