Ketchikan Pioneer Home-Upgrade Heating Ventilation and Air-Conditioning	Provide additional heating ventilation and air-conditioning services and ducting to the pre-school area.	\$75,000
Ketchikan Pioneer Home-Replace Fire Suppression System	Replace outdated fire suppression system in kitchen.	\$45,000
Ketchikan Pioneer Home-Resurface Concrete Ramps	Concrete ramps and walkways must be replaced to restore walking surfaces. Replacement of metal handrails is also recommended such that an appropriate and consistent height may be achieved.	\$195,000
Ketchikan Pioneer Home-Repair and Replace Metal Fencing	Repair and replace damaged fencing and repainting of metal surfaces is recommended to restore its condition.	\$25,000
