Project Description/Justification:

The Juneau Pioneer Home (the Home) will purchase and install 20 security cameras and subsequent digital video recording equipment. Currently, the Juneau Pioneer Home has no security cameras and no way to capture adverse activity at the entrances and common areas of the Home.

The security cameras will monitor those entering and exiting the building as well as provide valuable information when investigating potential issues with staff, residents and visitors. The security cameras and the information they provide will allow the Home to ensure and take the necessary steps to meet Alaska Statute 47.30.300, which specifically states that a resident of an assisted living home has the right to live in a safe and sanitary environment.

The Juneau Pioneer Home considered moving administrative staff to the front counter or soliciting volunteers to watch the entrances during non-business hours. However, this would not provide the full coverage that is needed and may not provide the necessary information needed for an investigation. It was determined that purchasing and installing the security cameras is the ideal solution to monitor these areas of the Home.
