Project Description/Justification:

Provide miscellaneous facility improvements, renovations, and upgrades associated with normal deterioration, equipment failures, mechanical upgrades, changing operational needs, changing security requirements, enhanced aesthetics, and other modifications at any of the airport owned building-type facilities. Examples of the types of projects that may be undertaken are as follows:

- Replace automatic and overhead doors
- Replace lighting fixtures with more energy efficient fixtures
- Replace/repair leaking window glazing, such as over the parking garage escalators
- Repair/rebuild escalators and elevators
- Build-out space for Transportation Security Administration (TSA) as needs change
- Replace/rebuild aged mechanical equipment
- Upgrade/expand telecommunications, security, access control and CCTV systems
- Diamond polish granite floors

- Repair roofing to extend useful life

Miscellaneous small projects are identified and need to be implemented in a timely manner to address aesthetics, safety issues, functionality, security concerns, building efficiency, etc. Some of the projects covered in this general category involve safety/or ADA requirements. It would be in the airport's best interest to address all issues that present a safety risk to the public and reduce the chance of injury/or lawsuits. Other possible projects (i.e. Telecom/Equipment Rooms) economic benefit would be determined based on tenant needs for expansion/or upgrading to newer technology. With the current status of telecommunications/equipment rooms, the ability to accommodate an additional air carrier/or other types of operations is fairly restricted.
