The existing section of the Glenn Highway between Buffalo Mine Road at MP 53 and MP 56 follows steep bluffs along the Matanuska River and reverses a canyon that contains Moose Creek. Existing grades reach 8% with horizontal curves dictating a 30 MPH design speed. This project will improve the section of highway to current standards.
