**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

This project ensures Anchorage International Airport (ANC) maintains compliance with all local, state, and federal laws. This would cover projects such as contaminated site remediation, storm water monitoring, treatment, and mitigation measures, and prevention of deicing fluids from entering the storm water system, maintaining spill prevention and response equipment for ANC tanks, assist tenants as required on environmental issues, upgrade and maintain Underground Storage Tanks (UST) as they relate to environmental requirements, air quality monitoring and mitigation to comply with state and federal Clean Air Act requirements, and hazardous waste monitoring and compliance.

**Project Description/Justification:**

This environmental compliance project would cover projects such as contaminated sites needing remediation, installing treatment and mitigation measures for storm water, monitoring of storm water from the airport and prevention of deicing fluids from entering the storm water system, maintaining spill prevention and response equipment for ANC tanks, assist tenants as required on environmental issues, upgrade and maintain Underground Storage Tanks (UST) as they relate to environmental requirements, air quality monitoring and mitigation to comply with state and federal Clean Air Act requirements, hazardous waste monitoring and compliance, and necessary specialized environmental consulting and construction services to meet the changing and updated environmental laws.

ANC is required to maintain compliance with all applicable environmental laws like any other industrial facilities. Failure to maintain or come into compliance in a timely manner can result in fines and

interruptions in normal airport operations.

ANC, as of November 2010, is in compliance with all environmental regulations. However, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is constantly upgrading and refining regulations that have an impact on the airport. Currently, EPA is in the rule making process for glycol runoff from aircraft deicing operations. In addition, EPA has recently increased the stringency of the Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures (SPCC) regulations as it relates to aircraft fueling operations. Additional regulations and requirements are anticipated.
