Project Description/Justification:

The development and implementation of coordinated signal plans will take into account the volume of traffic and the spacing of signals, varying by time of day, day of week, season, special event, and have to adapt to growth. Cameras will permit traffic engineers to respond to changing conditions with appropriate isolated location and coordinated signal system timing and provide real time travel information to the public. As stops are reduced and made more predictable there will be a reduction in rear end accidents. These technologies will make it possible in the future for local governments to take over management of the signals at a lower cost. Part of this and future authorization is expected to go to the Municipality of Anchorage to assist with their upgrades which include replacing failing obsolete controllers for which repairs parts are no longer available.
