**Project Description/Justification:**

There is significant bicycle and pedestrian traffic between the Brotherhood Bridge and UAS. Currently, this traffic must use the paved shoulder (also a designated bike lane) along Glacier Highway. Traffic speeds along this stretch reach 50 mph which creates unsafe conditions for pedestrians and bicyclists. There is reasonable pedestrian and bike access along Glacier Highway before Brotherhood Bridge, as well as beyond the UAS entry, but not along this two mile stretch.
