The project will include repairs and improvements to the Cold Bay Dock including, but not limited to: repair and modification of the steel pin pile fender systems and associated timber fender panels; the replacement of cracked pin pile; replace broken timber fender piles and replace pipe brackets; replace and/or repair damaged pre-stressed concrete deck panels. Additionally, repair or replacement of safety ladders, trestle guardrail and concrete wheel guards and other miscellaneous work where warranted to remedy structural, operational and safety deficiencies.
