Project Description/Justification:

Pavement on apron and sections of taxiway and runway has a low PCI and requires resurfacing. Subsurface drainage structures have settled and the resulting drainage deficiencies cause frost heave problems, humps in the pavement and flooding on the apron. Drainage problems can only be solved through elevating the grade of the apron. Some existing lease lots will be impacted resulting in a loss of one existing lot. In order to provide sufficient lease lots for existing tenants, the airport parking lot will be relocated from the apron to its ultimate location in accordance with the airport's master plan.
