**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

This project will add a sidewalk to Riverside Drive (both sides) between Egan Drive and Mall Road for a total distance of approximately .15 miles. It will also rehabilitate the roadway surface from Egan Drive to James Boulevard including pedestrian enhancements for a total length of approximately .32 miles.

**Project Description/Justification:**

This condition of pavement along this section of roadway is poor and in need of improvement. There are no sidewalks on either side of Riverside Drive from Mall Road to Egan Drive, creating a gap for pedestrians between major walkways that provide access to two grocery stores, the community library, the bus stop, the post office and two schools. The condition was exacerbated by the addition of the new high school in the area, with over 900 additional students. The school creates a significant amount of vehicle and pedestrian traffic in the area.
