Project Description/Justification:

This project will change insurance companies' access to Alaskan drivers driving records from a complicated nightly batch process and an FTP server to a real-time interface. Alaska residents will receive accurate insurance quotes on the same day rather than waiting for at least 24 hours. This also affords other authorized organizations real-time access to Alaska driving records.

What is the purpose of the project?

This project will enable fast and accurate insurance quotes and acceptance for Alaskan drivers and reduce the complexity of adding new authorized subscribers (insurance companies) to driving records.

This is an enhancement to existing capabilities.

How will service to the public measurable improved if this project is funded?

Alaska residents will receive accurate insurance quotes on the same day rather than waiting for at least 24 hours, thus allowing them to make accurate financial decisions, such as buying a new car, this instead of relying on estimated quotes from insurance companies.

Does project affect the way in which other public agencies will conduct their business?

While this project does not force any other public agencies to change their business processes it does afford the option for authorized agencies to have real-time access to driving records.

What are the potential out-year cost implications if this project is approved? (Bandwidth requirements, etc.)

- will reduce the time and complexity to add new authorized subscribers to driving records.
- will reduce space requirements on FTP servers.
- may increase bandwidth requirements slightly to accommodate XML documents.

What will happen if the project is not approved?

Alaska residents will continue to wait at least 24 hours before their driving records can be verified by insurance companies, to provide accurate insurance quotes.
