Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Currently, Pedro Bay transfers fuel to its bulk fuel facility and to residential customers utilizing a variety of independent tanks temporarily mounted in dump trucks, pick up trucks, or via a fork-lift. Equipment is not designed for this application. Safety is compromised and spill hazards are increased. Pedro Bay can no longer safely utilize these methods. A designated fuel truck and trailer unit can handle community needs and meets appropriate standards. A fuel tank truck and a trailer unit will be purchased and be transported to the village via barge services.

July 2014- Acquire bids for equipment

July/August 2014 - purchase equipment and complete logistics for freighting equipment to Pedro Bay.

October 2014- Project funds expected to be fully expended

WHEREAS: the Council has prioritized Pedro Bay's capital improvement projects in order to plan for timely development; and

WHEREAS: the Council seeks to officially update its capital improvement projects (CIP) list for 2013/14, and to solicit support and funding for its priority projects from local, state, and federal agencies;

3. Hydroelectric Project Feasibility/Construction
4. Public Dock/Waterfront Development (Smokehouse Bay)
5. New Housing Development (NAHASDA/Tribal)
6. Road Maintenance Facility
