Detailed Project Description and Justification:

This funding will be used to construct a sidewalk along 20th Ave. between Bragaw Street and Rosemary Street to provide a safe passage for pedestrians and students traveling along 20th Ave. during their walk to school at East High School. At this time, there is no sidewalk along this road and students are forced to walk in the street. This encourages unsafe behavior and with a designated pedestrian sidewalk these students and other pedestrians can stay off the road. This is a public safety issue, particularly during the winter months when large snow berms block a driver's vision making it very difficult, if not impossible to always see the students. The goal is to prevent an accident before it happens.
