## **Project Description/Justification:**

This pilot program began in FY2013, and is meant to encourage Alaska school districts to purchase nutritious food sources that are grown or harvested in Alaska. Grant funds will be apportioned two separate ways. Fifty-three percent of the funds will be allocated according to the 2013-2014 school year average daily membership of the school districts. The remaining 47 percent of the funds will be apportioned according to the 2013-2014 School District Cost Factor. The sum of the two amounts will be available to each school district for reimbursement of purchases under this program.

Under the Nutritional Alaska Foods for Schools program, a school district makes its purchases and submits a reimbursement request to the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development (DCCED). The request details quantities purchased, cost, and proof that products were Alaskan grown, or caught/harvested in Alaskan waters. DCCED then issues a reimbursement payment to the school district for the cost, up to the amount of the district's allocation. For this FY2015 funding, school districts have until June 30, 2015 to request reimbursement. Any remaining funds are distributed to districts based upon their 2013-2014 average daily membership.
