The unexpended and unobligated balance, estimated to be \$12,716, of the appropriation made in sec. 10, ch. 29, SLA 2008, page 48, lines 18 - 22 (Anchorage, Jewel Lake Road - construction of missing pedestrian and storm drain facilities - \$500,000) is reappropriated to the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.316 to the Anchorage School District to purchase books for the following schools in the amounts listed:

- (1) Dimond High School - \$3,179
- (2) Chinook Elementary School - \$3,179
- (3) Kincaid Elementary School - \$3,179
- (4) Sand Lake Elementary School - \$3,179.
