Project Description/Justification:

The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) is responsible for operating and maintaining three connected armory buildings in Kipnuk. One was built in 1960 and is 1,200 square feet, one was built in 1986 and is 1,300 square feet, and one was built in 2003 and is 1,500 square feet. This project repairs/replaces the failing boardwalk that connects the Armory to the city boardwalk. It also repairs/replaces the heating units and windows of the two oldest buildings to reduce energy consumption. All require the repair and leveling of their wood crib foundations. Priorities and cost estimates may need to be changed to accommodate emergency maintenance projects not listed, actual project costs, and other considerations.
