**Project Description/Justification:**

This project will provide for repairs and upgrades to existing facilities located within the Fairbanks regional office compound. The Fairbanks regional office compound is the largest owned facility within Alaska Department of Fish and Game. This project request includes funds to address a variety of ongoing Fairbanks needs. The highest priority projects include major roof repairs and replacements and electrical system upgrades and repairs. Any remaining funds would be used for a variety of other projects such as repair and upgrade public access roads and parking areas, repair and upgrade general building systems across the compound, repair and upgrade deteriorating curbs and sidewalks which are becoming a safety hazard, replace worn out flooring and carpeting in one half of the regional office workspace, and clean and recoat exterior finishes on several buildings throughout the compound.
