**Project Description/Justification:**

This project provides corrective and preventative maintenance and improvements for facilities in locations throughout Alaska. Facilities include both Alaska State Trooper and Alaska Wildlife Trooper posts and aircraft hangars, housing facilities, and evidence storage areas and other facilities.

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Many of the department's facilities are becoming increasingly maintenance-intensive as they age; some facilities are more than 30 years old. Regularly scheduled preventative maintenance, as well for emergency repairs, is essential to keep these facilities useful or even habitable.

Priorities and cost estimates frequently change to accommodate emergency maintenance projects and other factors. Examples include electrical and mechanical code compliance issues, along with energy and security improvements. Mostly general allocations are established for this project in order to keep the project administration flexible for the department to adapt to changing conditions.
