Project Description/Justification:

The Glenn Highway is the only corridor leading from the population center of Alaska, (the Anchorage and Mat-Su area), to all points east including Glenallen, Copper Center, Valdez, other Alaskan communities, and Canada. Steep grades, lack of shoulders, curve alignment issues, poor sight distance, lack of passing opportunities, and deteriorating asphalt make travel on the roadway challenging.
