Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

The Federal lands Access Program (FLAP) in a new MAP-21 program that provides funding through FHWA Western Federal Lands Division (WFL). The funding is intended to improve Access to federal lands. Projects are selected by a Programming Decision Committee (PDC) made up of representatives from WFL, Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) and the Alaska Municipal League. The PDC is required to cooperate with all applicable Federal Land Management Agencies. DOT&PF was awarded funding for two projects under the initial PDC selection process through cooperative efforts with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM).
