The flooding appears to be moving north and the highway may be impacted as far as milepoint 414. The overflow area is currently 24" to 30" higher than the readbed at the worst areas. Department of Transportation and Public Facilities state forces and equipment are clearing the highway to allow traffic as soon as possible. The off-road work will be performed by contractors to establish channels (approximately 20 miles) through the river ice with the intent to divert the overflow.
