Project Description/Justification:

Funding sanctions of 5% are imposed because Alaska does not have open container and repeat intoxicated driver laws that conform to federal laws (23USC154 and 23USC164).

A 2.5% penalty is assessed on the National Highway Performance Program and Surface Transportation Program funds from MAP-21 for Alaska not having an open container law, and 2.5% comes from not having a repeat intoxicated driver law. These penalties decrease the total amount of highway construction funds available to Alaska. The anticipated sanction on October 1, 2014 (FFY2015) is approximately \$21.5 million (100% federal).
