Project Description/Justification:

This project will purchase equipment that is required for a new Scout Battalion in Bethel. It provides vehicles and associated trailers allowing both small unit and individual movement over varying terrain in all seasons. It also provides communications equipment assisting with the command and control of small to large numbers of scouts across varying distances. This Scout Battalion will provide support to local communities during times of natural and manmade disasters. This will be a phased project requiring yearly equipment purchases of approximately \$1 million for the next five years to meet all requisite milestones and establish the foundation for a successful presence in Bethel.
