Project Description/Justification:

The existing building is no longer adequate to house the newer firefighting trucks that are being used. While the building is still usable, the equipment bays must be extended and widened, and the bay doors are in need of replacement. During the design of the remodel, it was determined that the building's heating and electrical systems also need to be upgraded or replaced to extend its useful life consistent with the other alterations. The additional funding requested will accommodate the additional work and other cost increases that have occurred since the project was originally programmed.
