This project will provide funds for highway and bridge reconstruction and rehabilitation projects on the portion of the Parks Highway located within the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities' (DOT&PF) Central Region. Eligible work includes resurfacing, reconstruction, drainage improvements, signage, guardrail, illumination and other improvements that prolong the life of road pavements, embankments, bridges and their safety related features.

Project Description/Justification:

This program is anticipated to provide support for the following Central Region projects on the Parks Highway:

Parks Highway - Milepost 48.8 to 52.3 Reconstruction - Pittman Road to Big Lake Road

This project will widen the Parks Highway to four lanes with attendant traffic and safety improvements between Pittman Road and Big Lake Road. The purpose of this project is to improve a serious safety problem and to increase the roadway's capacity to accommodate the projected traffic growth.

Parks Highway Bridge Replacement

This project will replace Bridge #215 at Montana Creek and Bridge #213 at Sheep Creek. The original bridges were constructed in 1962, and are structurally deficient.

Parks Highway - Milepost 123.5 to 163 Drainage and Culvert Improvements

This project will construct improvements to drainage including culvert repair, replacement, and new installations, as necessary to provide for adequate drainage.
