Project Description/Justification:

Seppala Drive is a main corridor in Nome that extends from Bering Street to Airport Terminal Road. Due to poor drainage the roadway has many dips and cracking occurs each year which requires extensive maintenance. Emergency vehicles must use Seppala Drive to transport patients from the Norton Sound Health Corporation to Alaska Airlines. Sidewalk improvements are desperately in need of rehabilitation to address Americans with Disabilities Act issues. The sidewalks are very narrow with uneven surfaces. Visitors and residents walking between the airport and downtown are forced to walk in the street due to the sidewalk deterioration.

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
