The Fire and Life Safety component will achieve reductions in expenditure levels by reducing travel for all staff and deleting two permanent full time positions: an Anchorage Building Plans Examiner II (PCN 12-2006), and a Fairbanks Office Assistant II (PCN 12-2016). As a result, turnaround times for initial review of building plans may increase to four weeks from two depending on the time of year and there will be one less level of review for requests to deviate from the published and adopted codes. Additionally, the development and adoption of new building and fire and life safety codes may be delayed. The Deputy Director will assume supervision of the Building Plans Examiner I positions. The Division of Fire and Life Safety / State Fire Marshal's Office has statewide jurisdiction for fire code enforcement and plan review authority except in communities that have received deferrals. These communities include Anchorage, Juneau, Fairbanks, Kenai, Ketchikan, Seward, Kodiak, Sitka, Soldotna, the University of Alaska Fairbanks, and the Wasilla Lakes Fire Service Area.

Court Service Officer (12-1965) transferred with funding from the Judicial Services component to the Alaska State Troopers (AST) Detachments component, within the AST RDU. The Bethel Judicial Services Office has a significant caseload and due to the separation from Anchorage Judicial Services, is unable to rely on other Court Service Officers to assist. When an increased need for paper service, prisoner transports, or court room security arises, assistance from the troopers at the Bethel Post is required. The use of trooper positions for these functions hinders the effective and efficient completion of the AST mission in the region. Currently Court Service Officer PCN 12-1910 is double filled to meet the needs of the department and to effectively serve the public. The relocation of PCN 12-1965 will allow the post to effectively manage the work load and remove the double fill.

If this Emergency Services Dispatcher I (ESDI) position is not established, the control rooms will have to be staffed by Court Service Officers (CSOs). This will result in each area having fewer CSOs available for prisoner transports, courtroom security and the service of court ordered paperwork. This is a very inefficient
