Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

Legislation increasing the motor fuel tax rate will require an update of the tax revenue management system (TRMS) and revenue online tax portal by a contractor. The update would consist of reprogramming both systems, updating the return rules in TRMS and testing both systems thoroughly to verify that they function as expected.
