Prior Funding History / Additional Information:

No prior funding history.

Project Description/Justification:

To maintain the use of Juneau Access Road funding in this region, and in recognition of Juneau’s role of this state’s Capital and a regional resupply and travel hub for the surrounding Lynn-Canal communities, the majority of the project funding will remain in the Juneau area for transportation and infrastructure projects. The remaining funding will be allocated between Skagway and Haines for ferry terminal enhancements such as those necessary to better accommodate the new Alaska Class Ferries and improving the safety of Marine Highway System Transport. Funds may be used either for grants to municipalities or nonprofits or work performed by state agencies on behalf of communities but all projects must meet the goal of improving transportation, safety, and necessary infrastructure in the communities. Final project allocations shall be determined after further discussion with Lynn Canal communities through a public process.
