The unexpended and unobligated balance, estimated to be \$1,605,479 of the appropriation made in sec. 10, ch. 29, SLA 2008, page 76, lines 25-26 as amended by sec. 16(b), ch 38, SLA 2015 (Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, Glenn Highway rut repairs), is appropriated to the Department of Corrections for security upgrades at correctional facilities.

Project Description/Justification:

Due to recent events and other ongoing security issues at the Yukon Kuskokwim Correctional Center (YKCC), one-time internal security upgrades are needed. The walls and cells at YKCC were constructed in the mid 1980's. The security concerns and inmate classifications at that time were not the same as the threat levels of today. Frequent inmate violent behavior along with gang activities has increased at YKCC. Assaults on officers and inmate on inmate violence has increased and new detention equipment is necessary to mitigate the opportunities for such activities. There are several security enhancements that will increase the security and safety at YKCC. The improvements will reduce the opportunities for assaults on staff and help prevent or prosecute other misconduct in the general population and segregation housing areas. The measures are:

- 1. Replace Segregation cell fronts with maximum security detention grade hardware
- 2. Install additional CCTV and intercom devices for additional 24/7 monitoring capabilities in Segregation and general population areas

- 3. Increase internal movement security control access with additional controlled door access in the main corridor
- 4. Redesign and increase security control access in the public visiting/professional visit conference area
