By centralizing this function within the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, the process of maintaining public facilities can become far more effective and efficient. With added accountability between the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (as the service provider) and customer agencies (the facilities owner), the process of maintaining these buildings can become far more streamlined and result in savings.
