These funds are generated from an excise tax on sport fishing equipment and marine fuels used by recreational boaters. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service distributes these funds to all states based on the number of sport fishing licenses sold and the size (land mass) of the state. Alaska receives the maximum share of DJ/WB funds which must be used to manage and improve sport fisheries and provide access to boating sites. To receive DJ/WB funds, state must have enacted legislation that prohibits sport fishing license revenues from being diverted out of the state's fishery agency. Diversion of Fish and Game funds are prohibited under AS 16.05.130. The Division of Sport Fish uses fish and Game funds to provide the 25% required match for a portion of these federal funds.
