Dear Finance Committee Co-Chairs,

Enclosed, please find a proposed amendment to the FY2019 capital budget totaling \$5.0 million in unrestricted general funds for an FY2018 supplemental capital project for the Wrangell junkyard contaminated site clean-up.

The Byford Junkyard in Wrangell cannot be redeveloped without appropriate cleanup of the known contaminants. To date, approximately \$15 million has been authorized from the Emergency Response Account for clean-up efforts. In response to local concerns about storing the contaminated soil on the island, an off-island disposal option is being pursued. This amendment is requested to cover the cost of shipping contaminated soil.
