Component: Administrative Services

Contribution to Department's Mission

Provide support services to Departmental programs.

Core Services

- Provide centralized administrative support services to the full range of programs and projects conducted by the department, including accounting, fiscal management, economic analysis, budget development, human resources, procurement, property control, contract and federal grants administration, information technology services, capital construction, facility maintenance and repair, and office space planning.
- Provide civil and criminal investigative support for complex environmental violations.
- Provide direct administrative support to the other components in the Administrative Services RDU, including the Commissioner's Office.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2018

The Administrative Service Component has undertaken a significant effort to reduce its lease costs. That effort began with the consolidation of the Anchorage Bayview office into the Olympic building on Cordova Ave in 2016. Since that time, an active effort has been underway to extend or renegotiate the lease in Juneau. In 2018, the Department successfully completed a limited competition RFP that resulted in the Department staying in its current Juneau building with a 22% reduction in space and a 25% reduction in total cost. That process also resulted in a multimillion dollar renovation to modernize the current building at no additional cost to the state. Additionally, in 2018 the Department successfully negotiated an extension to the Olympic building lease in Anchorage that results in an 8% savings in FY2019 and an 18% savings in FY2020. Likewise, that extension resulted in the owner completing extensive deferred maintenance (heating, cooling, lighting, etc.) at no additional cost to the state.

The Administrative Services Component hosts the central application development team that is responsible for CRITTS (Cost Recovery, Invoicing, and Time Tracking System). This system interfaces positive timekeeping information directly to the IRIS Human Resources module. During 2018, the application team successfully developed the algorithmic engine that automatically applies contractual business rules (leave, overtime, etc.) to every minute of time for every employee, which results in significant internal efficiency every time payroll is processed. Additionally during 2018, this system fully replaced the Department's legacy billing and invoicing system BillQuick, and it became the central repository of revenue clearing information. All of these improvements have resulted in a powerful all-encompassing database application that facilitates the Department's tip-to-tail revenue process.

During 2018, the Administrative Services Component facilitated the streamlining of the budget structures for the Division of Environmental Health and the Division of Water Quality, Infrastructure Support & Financing, Streamlining these divisions into single components will allow each of them to most effectively manage their limited general fund resources after many years of deep reductions.

The Department has now completed three full fiscal years in the new accounting and procurement system, IRIS. With each successive year, the Department's command of the system has become more robust. This maturation has resulted in more refined accounting structures that facilitate faster and more reliable expenditure and revenue reporting. Additionally, the Department has realigned its administrative processes to take advantage of IRIS's potential for automation and ease-of-use.

As part of the ongoing statewide IT consolidation, the Department eliminated its Juneau data center by transferring its Juneau-based servers and storage devices to a centrally managed data facility. This move reduced the need for data center space in the Juneau building, and it shifted the onerous technical responsibly for CJIS (Criminal Justice Information System) compliance that is integral to the Department's Environmental Crimes Unit.

Key Component Challenges

As in recent previous years, the recruitment and retention of administrative professionals is the most significant challenge for the Administrative Services Component, as well as the division-level administrative sections. Many recent recruitments have yielded fewer than three qualified applicants, and positions often remain vacant for many months until a successful candidate can be identified. During the recession several years ago, the Department successfully attracted many candidates from out-of-state, and many of those individuals are still serving the state. However, that tide has turned; Alaska's administrative professionals are increasingly going out-of-state to accept positions with more attractive wage and benefit packages. Our inability to attract and retain administrative professionals—including accountants, procurement professionals, and information technology specialists—has become a threat to our efficiency efforts. Turnover is costly, and less-experienced employees cannot deliver on the promise of more effective government.

The statewide consolidation of information technology personnel and assets stands to increase coordination and reduce costs in the long term. However, consolidations create anxiety and uncertainty. Anxiety and uncertainty, coupled with heightened scrutiny of new approaches have diminished near-term technological innovation. Application developers and other technicians have increasingly hewed to the status-quo. However, the technological landscape continues to advance—new platforms for communicating, new software tools, and new pieces of hardware. The Department finds itself falling behind the mainstream as it awaits the stabilization and maturation of the Office of Information Technology. Examples include inability to implement digital signatures, insufficient architecture for digital archiving of documents, and reluctance to pursue emerging technologies.

The Department pays its overhead costs (leases, admin/accounting, central chargebacks, etc.) in proportion to the direct personal services of all staff in the Department in compliance with an approved federal indirect rate calculation. The Department of Environmental Conservation is 30% funded by fees, but AS 44.46.025 and AS 37.10.054 prohibits the inclusion of overhead costs in the calculation of fees for services rendered to the public. Because overhead costs must be excluded from fee calculations, general funds must subsidize all fee-based activities. This induced subsidization of fee-based activities results in an overreliance on general funds to pay overhead costs. Despite the Department's relative success containing and reducing lease costs, many overhead costs continue to rise due to inflation and market factors.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2020

The Department transferred additional personnel in October 2018 to Shared Services of Alaska (SSOA) as part of the statewide consolidation of accounts payable activities. This new arrangement will prove-up during the remainder of FY2019, and it is expected to continue reducing overall cost for some accounting functions.

During FY2020, the Department expects to see the stabilization and maturation of the Office of Information Technology. This should result in lower costs and increased support for technological innovation.

In the FY2020 budget, the Administrative Services Component will true-up several of its receivable fund sources to maintain proportionality with direct expenditures. This change has no impact on the administrative services provided internally or to the public.

This organizational model reduces overall IT costs, strengthens IT functions, and maximizes efficiency.

The FY2019 budget included a statewide unallocated reduction to reflect savings achievable as a result of these efficiency efforts. An initial distribution of the savings has been made at the start of FY2019. The remaining savings will be distributed through the year as areas of efficiency continue to be identified.
