Major Component Accomplishments in 2018

Sex Offender Management Program (SOMP) had 356 sex offenders enter into sex offender treatment in FY2018. This included in-custody institutional programming and community programming for sex offenders on probation or parole.

In FY2018 the Department of Corrections was able to begin SOMP at the Wildwood Correctional Center, which increased the number of men receiving sex offender treatment while incarcerated with a capacity of 12 men.

Conducted 860 polygraph tests on sex offenders on probation and parole across the state.

In collaboration with the University of Alaska Anchorage, provided three statewide trainings that were available to providers, probation officers and the public. These trainings included sex offender treatment for Native Alaskan offenders as well as risk assessment training.

Established a telehealth program for sex offender treatment so that offenders may remain in their home communities and still access court-ordered treatment. This program provides sex offender assessments and 1:1 sex offender treatment services to offenders around the state. This allows more offenders to stay in their home communities and maintain stable housing and employment while accessing court ordered treatment.

Collaborated with the University of Cincinnati to provide training to all sex offender treatment providers on a new evidence based cognitive behavioral curriculum that can be used statewide for in custody and out of custody offenders.

Key Component Challenges

Continue to develop and modify sex offender management programs using recognized best practices in the field of sex offender management in both the institutional and community setting. This includes community safety, victim orientation, offender accountability, structure and consistency, quality control, and collaboration with other disciplines and entities.

Recruit and retain qualified staff both as therapists and probation officers willing to work with this difficult population, particularly within rural areas.

Limited community resources available for sex offenders being released who require treatment, supervision, basic needs and affordable housing.
