### **Contribution to Department's Mission**

Provide reformative programs to offenders.

#### **Core Services**

Education Programs

### **Major Component Accomplishments in 2018**

Continued to provide education courses that empower incarcerated individuals for marketable employment upon release, addressing the educational criminogenic factor and reducing the barriers for returning citizens.

Department of Corrections is the third largest contributor of successful General Education Diploma (GED) completions statewide and is expected to increase the number of GED diplomas for FY2019. GED completions are an Education Division priority and we have partnered with all adult basic education providers statewide. During FY2018, 107 offenders received their GED while incarcerated. This is primarily associated with increased tutoring as well as expanded knowledge of the computer software system.

#### During FY2018:

- 865 individuals received Adult Basic Education services.
- 799 individuals received services in the Criminal Attitudes Program; and 503 completed.
- 391individuals received services in the Anger Management Program; and 228 completed.
- 760 individuals received services in the Parenting Program; and 410 completed.
- 551 individuals received services in the Reentry program; and 323 completed.

### **Key Component Challenges**

Continue to educate and train education coordinators in evidence-based practices and continue to develop their professional skills to better deliver instruction.

Increase offender participation in the department's education programs to include Adult Basic Education/General Education Development (ABE/GED), Criminal Attitude Program (CAP), Parenting and the Alaska Re-entry Survival Program.

Collection of data to track the number of offenders completing an institutional education program. In addition, the department will begin tracking the re-incarceration rates of these, upon release, to determine the recidivism rates of offenders who completed these programs.

Educate stakeholders on what education programs are implemented in the department. This will enable the Alaska Court System and Parole Board to better align their conditions and recommendations to what is being offered to offenders while incarcerated.

Identify incentives for offenders to participate fully in their habilitation and take advantage of educational, vocational and re-entry program opportunities.

Recruitment and retention of well-trained providers to meet offenders reformative needs for successful re-entry and reduced recidivism.
