Major Component Accomplishments in 2018

Continued to provide vocational trade courses that empower incarcerated individuals for marketable employment upon release, addressing the educational criminogenic factor and reducing the barriers for returning citizens.

Provided vocational education services:

- 4,528 individuals received vocational education services with 3,548 individuals completing.
- 150 individuals received State Training Employment Program (STEP) Grant vocational classes in industrial trades with 150 individuals completing.
- 119 females from Hiland Mountain Correctional Center (HMCC) completed Construction Trades and received college tuition from Ilisagvik College using the Carl Perkins Grant.

Continued to expand vocational opportunities at Wildwood Correctional Center (WWCC) in Kenai. The vocational area was expanded utilizing several new precision wood machinery items for carpentry certifications. WWCC is capable of providing opportunities in welding certification, Industrial mechanics, heavy equipment operations and National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) Carpentry.

Key Component Challenges

Identify and implement vocational training programs that help prepare offenders for successful job placement when released.

Collect and track data on offenders who complete vocational training programs and assess program effectiveness.
