This funding will provide support to the Alaska Psychiatric Institute (API). A contract has been established with a private entity to address long-standing issues at API and to ensure the health and safety of all patients and staff. In FY2020, the contractor will receive \$3,266.5 for operational costs in addition to a per diem rate of \$1.4 per bed-day (\$40,407.4 based on 80 beds x 365 days/year). Given that the current FY2020 budget request of \$33,655.5, an additional \$10,018,600 will be required to support successful ongoing API operations.

into the system earlier in order to reduce the downstream costs of services. This will also allow Medicaid to pay for some services that can currently only be funded through grants. The 1115 waiver will develop the community-based and sub-acute emergency services system with in-home services, intensive outpatient services, mobile outreach and crisis response, 23-hour stabilization, and other services to reduce utilization of residential and acute services. These efforts will reduce the long-term costs of the behavioral health system and provider's reliance on grant funding.

The Governor's Amended budget included a \$12,000,000 reduction to Medicaid Services within the proposed savings target of \$225,000,000 in general funds. In order to meet this reduction, the Department will be transitioning general fund grant services to the Medicaid program. As such, the reduction more appropriately should reside in the Behavioral Health Treatment and Recovery Grant allocation. A corresponding amendment removes \$12,000,000 from the Behavioral Health Treatment and Recovery Grant allocation to Medicaid Services.

Since 2015, this group of providers has been able to capture an additional \$37.0 million associated with Medicaid expansion and \$22.3 million (a 17% increase) associated with traditional Medicaid in addition to the recent rebased rate of \$20.0 million. All told, there is nearly \$80.0 million in additional Medicaid reimbursements in the community behavioral health system today than there was in FY2015. The Department will continue to bolster these valuable services by capturing all available federal funding source while reducing the reliance on General Fund grants.
