Component: Overhaul

Contribution to Department's Mission

Overhaul all vessels of the Alaska Marine Highway System (AMHS) annually in order to maintain operational readiness of the fleet in a safe, reliable condition, and within regulatory guidelines.

Core Services

- Inspect and maintain all vessels in the AMHS fleet in accordance with the regulatory requirements of the United States Coast Guard (USCG), the American Bureau of Shipping (ABS), U.S. Code of Federal Regulations, 2000 High Speed Craft Code, Det Norske Veritas (DNV), Department of Environmental Conservation, Food and Drug Administration, Canadian enforcement agencies (as applicable), and International Safety of Life at Sea convention, in addition to state vessel maintenance policies.
- Manage all contracts necessary to accomplish the annual overhauls including those for dry-docking, hull and structure inspections, fire and lifesaving equipment inspections, repairs, cleaning, painting, and machinery overhaul.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2018

- Managed state overhauls for eight vessels at Vigor Alaska LLC's Ketchikan, Alaska ship repair facility.
- Received Certificates of Inspection for all nine vessels from the USCG.
- Completed Major mechanical overhaul evolution for M/V Kennicott resulting from reaching the 20-year service milestone. Mid-life refurbishment of the controlled pitch propeller system, reduction gears and fin stabilizers completed simultaneously.

Key Component Challenges

- Managing the volume of work needed to ensure safe and reliable operation of an aging fleet. With vessels reaching a half century or more of service, the list of material and mechanical deficiencies identified out-paces available resources. Discovery of unknown and unknowable conditions when undertaking needed work continues to put pressure on the limited capital budget and on human and material resources.
- Meeting ever-stricter safety and environmental standards during overhauls.
- Increased scrutiny of vessel condition and operational readiness by USCG and other regulators in the wake of
 recent marine casualties. This includes the enforcement of continuously updated and expanded regulatory rules
 and codes by USCG, ABS, and DNV.
- The need to focus available resources only on safety and regulatory needs to ensure continued operation for the
 public prevents quality of life improvements, modernization efforts, or substantial cosmetic work. Having to deny
 such work repeatedly due to capital constraints impacts morale and work output of onboard crew performing
 required maintenance. Managing the employee impacts requires increased efforts from managerial leadership.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2020

- Continued use of Results Based Alignment (RBA) methodologies to define desired outcomes of overhaul efforts
 in support of the department's mission. This will continue to improve the accuracy and efficiency of the overhaul
 program in delivering maximal impact for the funding provided.
- Use of RBA methodologies to identify future needs based upon observed results will continue to improve AMHS
 ability to accurately identify future funding needs and inform stakeholders of any changing needs.
- Efforts will continue to procure a new Maintenance Management System software for the fleet and shoreside facilities will improve forecasting of maintenance and repair needs with RBA.
- The evolution of the AMHS fleet makeup with the addition of the new Alaska Class Ferries will drive decisions on use of overhaul funds. Decisions about fleet make up and utilization will impact overhaul priorities and schedules. The layup of vessels to support operational realities will incur costs for preservation and stewardship.
