

Major Component Accomplishments in 2019

Business Development

- The division's Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) was embraced in its first year by government, industry partners, economic development organizations, and community partners around the state. During FY2019 the one-year update was completed, including a revised resiliency framework and Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities & Threats (SWOT) analysis.
- The Alaska Regional Development Organizations (ARDOR) program was reauthorized in FY2017; however, the ARDORs no longer receive funding from the State of Alaska. The division continues to maintain strong relationships with ARDOR representatives, offers support and technical assistance, and produces the annual ARDOR report.
- Conducted Made in Alaska workshop for permit holders to exchange information and collect applications from new businesses.
- The Made in Alaska program assisted over 1,000 businesses. Permit holders represent 83 communities throughout Alaska from Barrow to Ketchikan.
- Contracted the University of Alaska Center for Economic Development to complete five reports on emerging
 industries in Alaska. The first of these, Ship and Boat Building, was released in late 2017. The Renewable Energy
 report was released in April 2018 followed by the Aviation Report in June and Outdoor Recreation in 2019.
- Supported an exhibit at the Association of Mineral Exploration's "Roundup" conference in Vancouver, British Columbia in partnership with other state agencies.
- Produced a quarterly economic indicator report on behalf of the Alaska Industrial Development and Export
 Authority (AIDEA). This quarterly report highlights numerous economic indicators from shipping tonnage to fuel

prices in Alaska. The report was shared publicly on the division's website after use by the AIDEA Board of Directors.

- Coordinated two public meetings for the Alaska Minerals Commission. The division also assisted in compiling information for the January 2019 Annual Report.
- Participated in the Juneau Economic Development Council's annual Innovation Summit in February 2019.
- Presented at Spruce Root's Path to Prosperity small business financial workshop.
- Supported the 1 Million Cups Anchorage program, which hosts a weekly entrepreneur pitch event.
- Supported Opportunity Zones under the federal Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017.

Key Component Challenges

The division has been tasked with carrying out the Governor's "Open for Business" strategy. The division will provide strategic and financial analysis for existing and new business growth opportunities utilizing its core expertise and experience with research and statewide economic development strategy implementation. This will require the division's resources to be devoted to locating and developing opportunities to expand and diversify Alaska's economy by finding ways to support and incentivize new and existing business growth. Staff will need to rapidly become subject matter experts on the key industry sectors of Oil & Gas, Mining, Fisheries, Mariculture, Aviation, Transportation, Tourism, Military, Agriculture, Communications, manufacturing and Research & Development.
