RDU/Component Budget Summary

## **RDU/Component: Alaska Gasline Development Corporation**

## **Contribution to Department's Mission**

Advance the development, financing, construction and operation of a North Slope natural gas pipeline project, an in-state natural gas pipeline and other transportation mechanisms capable of delivering natural gas and other non-oil hydrocarbons for the maximum benefit of Alaskans.

### **Core Services**

- Provide economic benefit to the State by securing a stable, long-term supply of natural gas for Alaskans.
- Commercialize Alaska's enormous North Slope gas reserves.
- Structure the Alaska Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) project to secure credit worthy customers and contract with major engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) firms to make the project attractive to potential partners and investors.
- Maximize the ability for public utilities and industrial customers, within close proximity to a North Slope natural gas
  pipeline, to access gas. Coordinate with the Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority (AIDEA), the
  Alaska Energy Authority (AEA) and other state agencies on the planning and development of infrastructure to
  deliver affordable energy to areas of the state not expected to have direct access to a North Slope natural gas
  pipeline.
- Advance the Alaska Stand Alone Pipeline (ASAP) project through the final federal regulatory process for the
  purpose of making natural gas available to Fairbanks, Southcentral and other communities within the state at the
  lowest possible cost. ASAP is the backup project for the Alaska LNG.
- Continue to advance and finalize commercial discussions with LNG buyers across the Asia-Pacific region for the Alaska LNG project. The advancement encompasses in-state gas issues, discussion with producer partners, federal support, and project financing.

## Major Component Accomplishments in 2019

- Signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with ExxonMobil, BP, China Petrochemical Corporation (Sinopec), CIC Capital Corporation (CIC Capital), and Bank of China to develop the venture structure for the Alaska LNG Project.
- ExxonMobil, BP, and the Department of Revenue reviewed the economic viability of the Alaska LNG Project. An analysis of the overall cost estimate indicated potential cost savings of major elements are achievable with high level of confidence. The lower cost inputs into the common economic model resulted in lower cost LNG, competitive with market prices.
- Received a Joint Record of Decision from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Bureau of Land
  Management for the Alaska Stand Alone Pipeline Project (ASAP). The environmental and engineering work
  completed for ASAP is being used by the Alaska LNG Project to avoid duplication of efforts and minimize project
  development costs.
- Received FERC's Notice of Revised Schedule for the Alaska LNG Project in Federal Register.
- Received FERC's Notice of Availability of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the Proposed Alaska LNG Project Federal Register.

### **Key Component Challenges**

AGDC is maintaining its current level of operations to ensure leadership, staff, and knowledge continuity. AGDC activities focus on the areas of venture structuring, financial, regulatory, and technical processes. AGDC is working with BP and ExxonMobil on completion of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) authorization. BP and ExxonMobil are providing funds and subject matter experts, as needed, to accomplish this effort. The parties are also looking at potential venture structures for the next phase of project development. This could include existing parties in addition to new venture partners. Outreach to potential partners is underway.

## Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2021

- Continue to develop a venture structure that will lead to successful equity and debt financing of the project.
- Completion of the Alaska LNG project in the FERC National Environmental Policy Act regulatory process.
- Receipt of FERC order authorizing construction and operation of the Alaska LNG Project, if not received in FY2020.
- Receipt of other major federal permits and authorizations of the Alaska LNG Project.
- Solicit and receive investment from outside parties in Alaska LNG. Investment funding will support the project as it plans for front-end engineering and design (FEED).
