The Division of Agriculture administers Special Crop Block Grant Funding provided by the United States Department of Agriculture. These grants are provided to university and industry applicants for research related to specialty crops produced and marketed in Alaska. The 2018 Federal Farm Bill also included a Food Security Micro-grant program. Alaska is slated for \$4 million a year for 4 years.

Project Description/Justification:

The Division of Agriculture administers the university research program for the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). The research leads to the effective management of specialty crops by defining proper inputs, developing strategies to deal with pests and other problems. It also increases market opportunities and gains better product quality, and in return helps with market development and cooperative industry coordination.

The Food Security Micro-grant program is designed for increased food production (i.e. greenhouse – hydroponic systems) in Alaska. These are simple grants which are \$5,000 per person or \$10,000 per group. These grants can be pooled, and there is only a 10 percent match with a report on the project due upon completion.

Prior Funding History/Additional Information

A Technical Specialty Crop Assistance Grant for \$1.4 million was granted to the Division in FY2020. This grant was included in the FY2020 Capital Budget.
