Contribution to Department's Mission

The Public Information Center facilitates one-stop public interface for divisions and offices of the Department of Natural Resources (DNR).

Major Component Accomplishments in 2019

The Public Information Center (PIC) assisted approximately 25,000 customers and processed over \$20.1 million in revenues.

Produced or assisted in distribution of over 70 media releases.

Assisted in the marketing, implementation, and in-person sales for three new land sales and other continuing sales in FY2019, each with different rules of participation.

Assisted the Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation in counting, receipting, and depositing \$222,101 in day use, camping, and boat launch fees for Chugach State Park and Mat-Su Area Parks.

Assisted in maintaining over 50 DNR web pages and fact sheets that efficiently relay information to the public.

Continued collaboration with the Division of Mining, Land & Water in developing a streamlined initiation and receipting process for new mining claims, including a public-facing online submission portal, that will decrease processing time and errors that may cause abandonment or the need for amendments.

Collaborated with the Division of Mining, Land & Water to modify and update land sales web pages and internal processing tools.

Key Component Challenges

Retaining and training staff.

Developing efficient processes and tools to meet the volume of public inquiries and demand for administrative support while maintaining excellence in customer service.

Expanding and improving web-based information and services.

Continuing collaboration with DNR divisions and sections to troubleshoot the implementation of new fee regulations that took effect in July 2018.

There are no significant changes in results anticipated.
