## **Major Component Accomplishments in 2019**

Revamped the State Branded Agricultural Program to accommodate a membership structure, merchandise fee structure, and marketing supplies sales for a sustainable future.

Hosted our first International trade activity related to agricultural businesses and Canadian buyers interested in retail products. This activity leveraged \$50,000 from our partner organization Western US Agricultural Trade Association and preliminary estimates indicate sales projections of nearly \$500,000.

The division received a \$1,376,011 grant for Technical Assistance for Specialty Crops: Eliminating Pest-Related Trade Barriers for the Alaska Grown Peony Trade Industry from USDA Foreign Agricultural Services.

Conducted inspections and issued approximately 85 federal Phytosanitary Certificates for Alaska timber, cut flowers, and other various agricultural products for export. Certified approximately 90,000,000 board feet of timber for export to Asian markets for Alaska timber producing companies.

Supported multiple projects around the state by administering and managing nearly \$900,000 of USDA Specialty Crop Block Grant Projects representing 20 projects around the state.

In cooperation with the Division of Mining, Land and Water, successfully sold 663 acres of agricultural land from five parcels into private ownership. Approved State Farm Conservation Plans on five parcels which ranged from 40 to 3,030 acres.

## **Key Component Challenges**

Increasing plant health inspections and surveillance of plant material imported into Alaska.

Offering agriculture land sales annually while continuing efforts to provide agricultural opportunities to Alaskan entrepreneurs to access state agricultural lands.

Maintaining staffing levels and working with changing programmatic priorities.

Adequate resources to identify and manage (eradicate and prevent) invasive plants and pests.

## Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2021

Full transition from Farm to School Program housed at the Division of Agriculture to the Department of Education. In the future the division will be funded as a partner liaison to bridge the agriculture industry to the school food market with their staff taking the lead on the work. The division will be funded as a mentor and transition partner instead of the primary program implementation point.

International trade and export partnerships have improved by working with Alaska Seafood Marketing Institute, US Department of Commerce International Trade Administration, and Alaska Department of Commerce.

Increasing partnerships with existing and new funding sources to leverage travel funds. This includes a focus on Farm to School, Specialty Crop, Technical Assistant for Specialty Crop, Western US Agricultural Trade Association, Crop Risk Management, Country of Origin Labeling, Phytosanitary Inspection, Cooperative Agricultural Pest Survey, and egg shell Surveillance which allows program presence in communities with less reliance on general funds.

Increased cross-training of staff to find efficiencies across disciplines.

Increased and continued survey for exotic pests in areas at risk for introduction due to ship and passenger traffic and on imported material destined to nurseries and retail nursery stock dealers across Alaska.

Working with Division of Mining, Land, and Water on land sale responsibilities thereby increasing efficiencies within both divisions.

Working on updating agriculture land covenants.

Transfer North Latitude Plant Materials Center to Agricultural Development for project collaboration. The Division of Agriculture works closely on related projects with budget components within Fire Suppression, Land & Water such as Mining, Land & Water (DMLW) and Forest Management & Development.

The Division of Agriculture and DMLW will operate the Agricultural Lands Sales program as a joint project. The Division of Agriculture develops agricultural sales projects. When the project is ready for an actual sale, the DMLW Land Sales Section will do the land sales process. Upon completion of the sale, the Division of Agriculture staff will manage the on-the-ground supervision and paperwork. The DMLW contracts section will then manage the contracts. Upon receipt of patent, the Division of Agriculture team manages the ongoing agricultural issues such as farm plans. The process of completing the project goes back and forth between the divisions. Transferring the division will provide more operational latitude to the divisional managers as each land sales project moves through the process.

Forest Management has several federal grant programs with the United States Department of Agriculture that overlap with the work of the Division of Agriculture. Moving the Division of Agriculture with these budget components will provide more efficiencies in the budgeting and management process of mutual projects. This movement will reduce staffing and programmatic redundancy between the two components.
